



FDA Status

Pinnacle's 2180H polypropylene as marketed by Pinnacle Polymers Company, in natural, uncolored pellet form is covered under US FDA Food Contact Notification 864. As such, this polymer complies with the requirements of CFR Title 21 and can be used in contact with all food types under Conditions of Use A-H.

Condition of Use:

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| A. High temperature heat-sterilized (e.g., over 212 °F) |
| B. Boiling water sterilized |
| C. Hot filled or pasteurized above 150 °F |
| D. Hot filled or pasteurized below 150 °F |
| E. Room temperature filled and stored (no thermal treatment in the container). |
| F. Refrigerated storage (no thermal treatment in the container). |
| G. Frozen storage (no thermal treatment in the container). |
| H. Frozen or refrigerated storage: Ready-prepared foods intended to be reheated in container at time of use: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Aqueous or oil-in-water emulsion of high- or low-fat.2. Aqueous, high- or low-free oil or fat |
